



EXTERNAL ACCESS – PATIENT REPORTS AND IMAGES

There are two ways you can conveniently access patient reports and images online when outside of the St Vincent's network:

- Via InteleConnect EV - our online portal
- Via InteleViewer on desktop computer

For each of the options listed there is a unique set-up process.

Log in to our external online portal

SVHA employees can use their SVHA credentials via InteleConnect EV in an Internet browser – Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari - to simply log in below.

If you have a SVHA account, your SVHA Username and Password will allow you access from within or external to SVHM. Do not create a new account.

Download software to access reports and images externally to SVHA network online via IntelViewer

Intelviewer is a diagnostic viewer that needs to be installed onto your desktop computer. It provides fast and efficient viewing across all modalities and bandwidth.

It's best for viewing complex procedures such as MRIs and CTs, and you can compare current images with historical data.

Install IntelViewer

Open an Internet Browser – Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari,

1. In the Address field type:
 - <https://pacs.svhm.org.au/IntelViewer-tracks/stable/>
2. Select the appropriate installer listed for your operating system
 - The selection matches your desktop operating system (ie. 64 bit, Mac OS)
3. Double click the download installer file, and the installation process will begin
4. Accept the terms and press NEXT (next two screens)



5. Press NEXT (next 3 screens)



6. Click **Done**

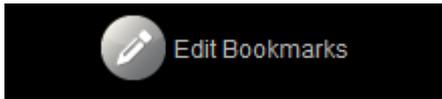


Adding Bookmarks for InteleViewer

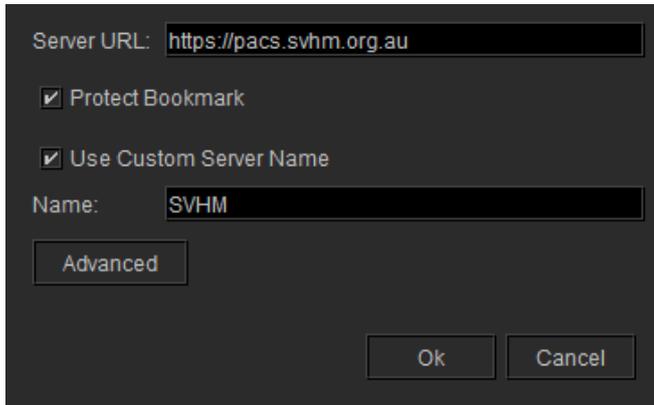
1. To begin, double click on the InteleViewer icon



2. Either a message to add a New Server will appear (if this is a new installation) or Click on Edit Bookmarks



3. Click on Add and enter the fields as shown
